# What must I do before attending New Employee Orientation?

- ▶ Complete the pre-placement assessment and drug screening.
- ▶ Complete all courses listed and score 80% or higher.

# What should I wear?

- ▶ Professional Appearance
- ▶ Presenting a professional appearance is extremely important. When we present a professional and welcoming image, it instills trust and confidence to our patients and their families. Please use the following guidelines when dressing for orientation:
- ▶ If you do not wear scrubs in your position or prefer to dress differently for your orientation dates, please dress in business casual attire (NO jeans or t-shirts allowed). Otherwise, scrubs are welcomed.
- ▶ Visible tattoos are permitted as long as they are not offensive.
- ▶ We are a fragrance free environment, so please refrain from using scented lotions or perfumes.

# What do I need to bring with me?

- ▶ Two original forms of identification as required for the I-9 form.
  - ▶ License, certification, registration, BLS card, ACLS card and/or driver's license if required by your position.
- 

# What should I not bring with me?

- ▶ You should not bring personal electronic devices such as iPod, iPad, laptop, camera, tape recorders or other personal portable audio or video devices to work with you.
  - ▶ If you bring your personal cell phone, you should leave it on silent and refrain from talking or texting except on break periods.

# When will I receive my first pay check?

- ▶ Med Center Health employees are paid on a bi-weekly schedule. Your pay will be directly deposited into your bank account on Friday morning of a pay week.

# How do I create my computer password?

On your first day of New Employee Orientation you will be asked to create a **confidential password** that will allow you access to the appropriate computer systems. Please be thinking about your password using the parameters listed below.

- ▶ Must contain at least 8 characters and cannot contain your name
  
- ▶ Must contain the following:
  - At least one upper case letter AND
  - At least one lower case letter AND
  - At least one number OR
  - Special Character (!@#\$)
